

The North Lamar Independent School District requires that all students who need medication during school hours must do the following:

1. All medicine is to be brought to and kept in the school nurse's office.
2. Present this form signed by the parent or legal guardian.
3. If it is a prescription medication, it must be sent in the ORIGINAL prescription container labeled for the student receiving the medication at school.
4. If it is a non-prescription medication, it must be in the ORIGINAL container and have the student's name on it.
