

Bus Discipline Procedure

Students have been given a set of rules to follow for safety of all passengers on the school bus. If a student breaks these rules they will be reported to the principal's office. The student can expect the principal to follow this procedure in disciplining the students. The driver is in charge of the bus and has the authority to assign seats at anytime during the year.

First Offense – warning by the bus driver and written notice mailed to parents/guardian.

Second Offense – Parent conference required with principal before the student is allowed to continue to ride the bus.

Third Offense – 10 days suspension off bus.

Fourth Offense – Suspension remainder of semester off bus.

If any offense concerns disrespect toward the driver, fighting, profanity, and other acts similar that are dangerous to the other passengers, steps mentioned prior could be skipped due to severity of incident by discretion of the principal and/or transportation department.

In case of serious misconduct that endangers the safety of other passengers or the driver, the student(s) may be removed from the bus by any school official or law enforcement assistance. In such an instance, the student shall not be provided bus service until a parent/principal conference is held.

Bus rules are subject to be amended or reviewed and changed each year.

THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY THE DRIVER AND BACKED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

Any violation of bus rules on the last day of school, students will be subject to discipline the beginning of the Fall.
